**New Realm**

Straight out of Lafayette, Louisiana, arrives portraitist Amy Guidry, whose paintings walk a fine line between photorealism and pop surrealism. There are many touchstones in her work — everything from Lewis Carroll's fantasy images to Dave McKean's graphic novel illustrations — but Guidry's latest exhibit, *New Realm*, at the recently opened Henri & Odette gallery in downtown Las Vegas, betrays a darker Southern gothic streak that viewers will likely relish.

Just in case you suspect Guidry came out of nowhere, she hasn't. Her paintings have appeared in magazines like *Newsday*, and one piece in particular was featured in *Real World: Season 20*. *New Realm* is very different, however.
